A pick up and haul away service for large items is also available for a fee (\$100 for two TVs at same location).

Solid Waste Services offers electronics recycling for businesses at the Anchorage Regional Landfill Hazardous Waste Center (in Eagle River off of Hiland Road). Computer monitors 19" or smaller are \$30 each, computer monitors larger than 19" are \$35 each, and all other computer components and office equipment with circuit boards such as telephones, adding machines, fax machines, printers etc., are 50¢ per pound.

Each spring, usually in April, Cook Inletkeeper hosts an electronics recycling collection event in Homer. Households pay a flat fee of \$15 per carload, businesses pay 35¢ per pound and non-profit organizations pay 25¢. Additionally, cell phones and MP3 players can be dropped off at the Cook Inletkeeper office year round for free recycling.
